


CLINTON & TRUMP

Affordable Care Act

- Defend and expand the ACA
- Better incentivize states to expand Medicaid
- Lower medicare to age 55
- Repeal and replace ACA with Health Savings Account
- Use block grants to allow for the design of innovative Medicaid programs for low-income citizens
- Allow insurance purchase across all states

Prescription Drugs

- Protect consumers from rising prices by increasing pharmaceutical company competition
- Increase safe/effective access to treatments internationally
- Create penalties for exuberant price increases

Women's Health

- Protect women's right to choose
- increase contraceptive accessibility
- improve access to primary care
- No stated position in policy outline
- Verbally confirmed pro-life stance
- Would defund planned parenthood
- Believes in punishment for abortion

Mental Health

- Launch nationwide initiative for suicide prevention
- Better coordinated primary and mental healthcare
- Enforce Mental health Parity Act
- Invest in research
- Improve mental health to reduce gun violence
- Fortify mental health service for veterans

Equal Pay

- Pass "Paycheck Fairness Act" to ensure equal pay
- No stated position in policy outline

2nd Amendment

- Prevent domestic abusers, violence offenders, & the mentally ill from obtaining guns
- expand background checks
- Limit regulations for background checks
- Lift gun and magazine bans
- "Right to carry" laws in all states

Vaccination

- Verbally supported child vaccine mandates
- No stated position in policy outline
- Questioned role of vaccines in autism
- Modify child vaccine schedules

Environment

- Defend, implement & extend smart pollution/efficiency through Clean Power Plan
- Invest in clean energy
- Cut tax subsidies of oil/gas companies
- Promote conservation
- Revitalize coal communities
- Make America energy independent through revitalization of coal/oil industries & increasing off-shore/shale drilling
- Eliminate EPA's clean power plan
